

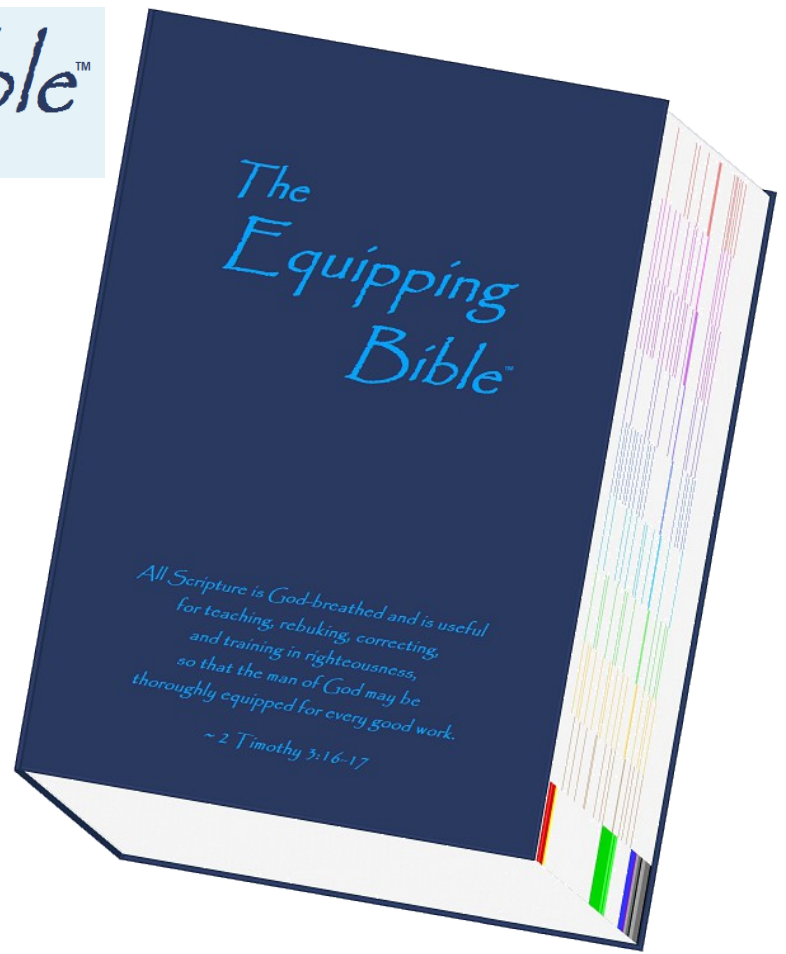
The Equipping Bible™


